**CRAIG ARCHIBALD APPOINTED TO
DHA BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

DENVER, CO -- The Denver Housing Authority (DHA) announced today that Mr. Craig Archibald has been appointed by Mayor John Hickenlooper and confirmed by the Denver City Council as a member of its Board of Commissioners. Mr. Archibald will serve on the Board through 2015.

Mr. Archibald brings expertise in housing development and financing to the DHA Board with professional experience as the former Chief Executive Officer of Urban Peak, Inc., Principal of New City Lofts, LLC, Project Manager at Urban Neighborhoods, Inc., and his former position of Deputy Executive Director of the Colorado Housing and Finance Authority. He holds a Masters in Public and Private Management from the Yale School of Organization and Management, a Master of Arts in Political Science from the University of Michigan and a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Colorado.

Mr. Archibald also serves on the board of Parent Pathways and has been active in several other community and nonprofit organizations.

DHA was established in 1938 as a quasi-municipal corporation with an annual budget of \$140 million. DHA is one of Denver's largest subsidized landlords, serving 25,700 very low, low and middle income residents and managing over 10,700 dwelling units located throughout the city.
